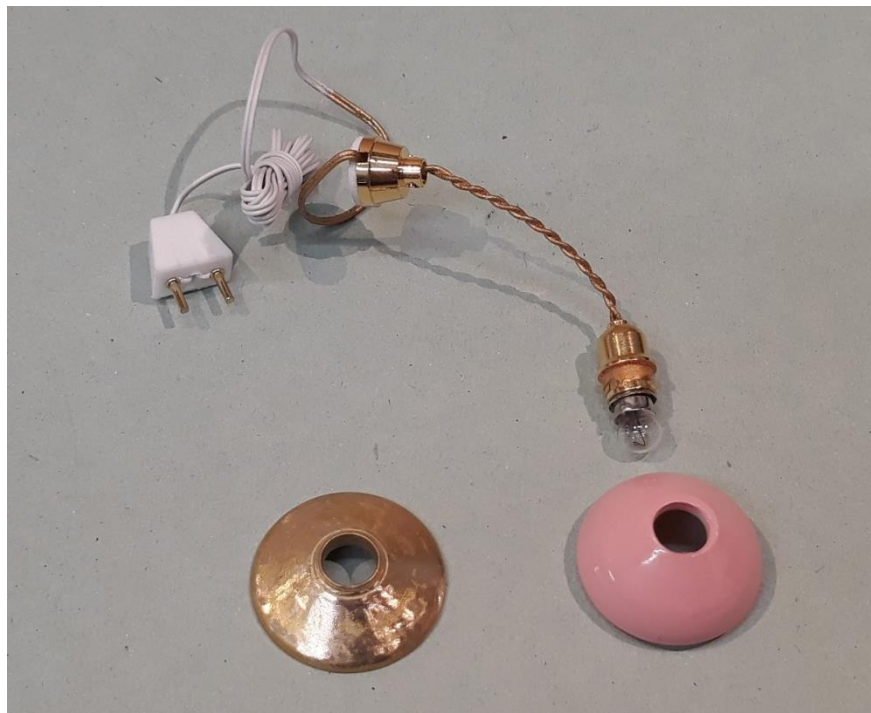
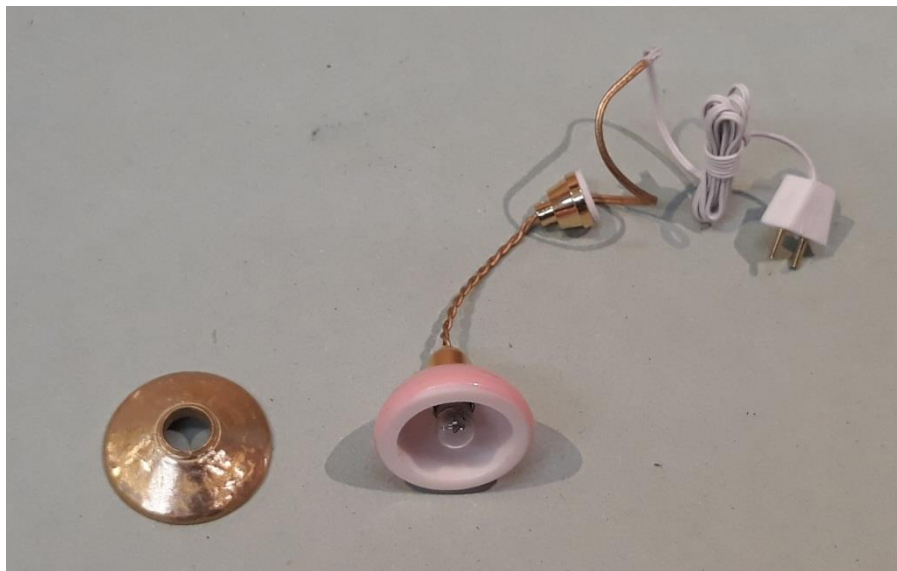

Lighting

The Lampshade is designed to be used in conjunction with dolls house light fittings from The Dolls House Emporium these work best with their 6053 or 5178 there are others with the same fitting but the Pea Bulb 5203 as fitted is the better one for this item

First carefully pull off the doll's house lampshade and remove the bulb putting aside for safe keeping





Clean up any feed sprues remaining on the lampshade and tidy up with a file and abrasive paper.

Prime the brass casting and paint the inside satin or matt white for the reflector and your chosen colour for the shade these were typically dark green also paint the bulb holder once these are dry as required push fit our shade in place.

At this point the conversion is complete; however this can now be used in a variety of different ways either by using the doll's house plug fitting or hiding the cable in the fabric of the building or by cutting off the plug the cable can be threaded through KS Brass tube #1268



The tube can be formed into a swan neck by heating the tube up to cherry red with a blowtorch allowing to cool and then inserting a thin plastic rod to stop the tube from collapsing careful form the bend, then the plastic rod can be burnt out and the tube cleaned up, the wire for the lamp can now be threaded through the tube and secured with CAA adhesive to the shade
